- Child must be a resident of the City of Walla Walla or Walla Walla County or the City of Milton Freewater.
- The Child must be in grades 4 thru 8th
- The child must be able to tolerate loud noises, wear a uniform and able to sit through a swearing in ceremony.
- The students who are chosen will be given an emergency service uniform from their designated service branch and a badge. There will be a picture day and lunch with their Chief in late July, and "swearing-in" ceremony at the National Night Out in Pioneer Park on August 5, 2014. The student may also ride in an emergency service vehicle during the Walla Walla Fair & Frontier Days Parade.
